Pee Wee Division Fall Rules Continued

Specific Pitching Rules

- A pitcher is determined to have thrown an inning against their limit as soon as one pitch has
- Pitchers who have thrown one pitch or more may be removed from pitching and brought back to pitch one time.

Specific Running Rules

- Baserunners may not leave the base they currently occupy before the pitched ball corssed
- Any batter who recives a walk may not advance past first base until the next ball is pitched. All runners forced to advance on a walk may only advance one base, and may not advance more at their own risk.

Additional Information for Highlighted Rules (See point#)

- **Point 1:** When the drop dead point is reached, the at bat in progress may be finished, and the game will conclude following this.
- **Point 2:** There will be a 15 minute grace period if a team does not have 8 players, players who arrive after the start of the game will be added to the end of the line up.
- **Point 3:** Failure to comply with this rule or encouraging of players to arrive late or not show up with result in disciplinary action
- **Point 4:** Forfeits are not allowed in RBBA Fall Baseball. Coaches are encouraged to work with the umpires and the opposing coach to determine a way to play.
- **Point 5:** Runners may only steal once the ball has crossed home plate. If a runner is determined to have left the base they occupy before the ball crosses the plate, a strike will added to the count of the batter as a penalty.
- **Point 6:** Base coaches are required to wear base helmets provided by the RBBA. Coaches may not be allowed on the field at any point and will be prevented from taking the field without a base coaches helmet.
